FINANCIAL POLICIES

The Comprehensive Fee and other additional program fees are due and payable in full for the entire school year by July 15 or upon acceptance. A reservation will not be held until full payment is received. A student who leaves during the school year for any reason whatever (either voluntary withdrawal or dismissal) is still responsible for the entire yearly fee.

All accounts must be paid on time. A late fee of 1 1/2% will be charged monthly on any outstanding balance.

A parent's account - including all fees, fines, or special charges - must be paid in full (or satisfactory financial arrangements made with the Board of Directors) before a graduating senior will be permitted to participate in graduation exercises or before the student's diploma will be released.

TEXTBOOK FEES

In early July, you will be able to buy your books online through Classbook.com or over the phone. You are responsible for purchasing your textbooks. Do not arrive on campus without your textbooks. Approximate costs \$250 - \$400 per student.

PASSPORT LEARNING PROGRAM (Cost approx. \$900 - \$1,200)

1st Year students are required to enroll in the Passport Learning Program.

How does Passport Learning work? First, we give the student a variety of skills tests. These tests determine where the reader is weak in the following areas of reading: visual, audio-visual, and oral. Second, we assign the student a personalized course of instruction that targets his "reading gaps." Everything is done on a computer, but an instructor will always be present if the reader has any questions. This computerized course includes drills, exercises, checkups, and awards as the student completes each level. **Who can benefit from Passport Learning?** Elementary-level children, teenagers, adults, those who speak English as a second language—basically anyone who struggles with reading will benefit from Passport Learning.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT COMPREHENSIVE FEE

In order to streamline the registration process and to assist international students with their particular needs, a **Comprehensive Fee (\$18,440 for Grades 9-12 --- \$17,730 for Grades 7-8)** will be charged. This fee includes tuition, room and board, registration, school health insurance, and various other activity and course fees. Our goal is to insure a positive experience and "peace of mind" for both student and parent. This is an all-inclusive fee.
